Conducted January 10-12, 2011 at the Grand Hotel in Taipei, Taiwan, the Summit focused on strategies for operators to generate high-margin revenue through post- and pre-paid Global Roaming. The event was open to all operators and a select list of vendors and included representatives from Sprint Nextel, Packet One Networks, UQ Communications, wi-tribe, and ITRI of Taiwan. As part of the incredible feedback that we received for this event, Indian operator BSNL asked the WiMAX Forum to help them conduct a similar summit in Delhi aimed at helping BSNL's WiMAX franchisees learn best practices to deploy their greenfield WiMAX networks. This event, the WiMAX Network Deployment Workshop, is taking place in New Delhi from February 22-23. More details are available inside this issue.

WIMAX FORUM NEWS

WiMAX™ on Track to Cover One Billion by EOY 2011

BARCELONA – February 15, 2011 – The WiMAX Forum announced that WiMAX service providers around the globe today have networks covering more than 823 million people (or POPs) in approximately 149 countries and are on track to reach one billion POPs by the end of 2011. This estimate is a growth of 215 million POPs since December 2009 and surpasses the forecasted growth during that time period.

"WiMAX networks continued to grow at a steady pace, despite a slow global economic recovery and competitive technologies starting to enter the market," said Ron Resnick, president and chairman of the WiMAX Forum. "In 2010, the WiMAX Forum and the worldwide ecosystem continued its diligent work to deliver an evolutionary path from WiMAX Release 1 to WiMAX Release 2, based upon IEEE 802.16m, to help safeguard operators' network investment for future upgrades."

Regional growth varied based on several factors including the local economy, existing mobile infrastructure and spectrum availability. The strongest growth occurred in the United States through Clearwire's network expansion and in the Asia-Pacific region, specifically Japan, Korea, Malaysia and the Philippines.

In 2010 the WiMAX Forum continued to see stable growth in Eastern Europe. Some CIS counties doubled their population coverage, and operators across the region are expected to expand WiMAX coverage to new population centers over the next year. The Latin America market saw slow growth due to ongoing spectrum auction delays.

By region, WiMAX Forum research uncovered the following growth:

Asia Pacific leads with more than 322 million POPs, an increase of nearly 100 million in the past year. Europe had modest growth to 135 million people covered by WiMAX.

North American coverage increased to 127 million from 47 million POPS.

Africa/Middle East covers more than 121 million POPs.

Central/Latin America reached nearly 118 million POPs.

India saw slow WiMAX growth throughout 2010 due to delays in network rollouts. However, over the next year, the WiMAX Forum expects to see strong network growth in India. BSNL has committed to deploy 20,000 base stations over the next 36 months through the use of regional franchisees. BSNL has established multiple contracted revenue sharing franchisees for urban roll out and service delivery across India. On February 22-23 of 2011, WiMAX Forum and BSNL are jointly hosting the WiMAX Network Deployment Workshop in New Delhi, an interactive event for BSNL's

Franchisees to gain a concrete understanding of the necessary steps involved in deploying a Greenfield WiMAX network.

Two-day workshop to provide BSNL Franchisees with insights on successfully deploying WiMAX™ networks in India

NEW DELHI – February 16, 2011 – WiMAX franchisees from across India will gather in New Delhi next week to learn best practices for deploying greenfield WiMAX networks. In the past two years, BSNL has installed around 1600 WiMAX base stations, and plans to install an additional 20,000 base stations over the next 36 months. BSNL has established multiple contracted revenue sharing franchisees for urban roll out and service delivery across India. The WiMAX Network Deployment Workshop in New Delhi will be an interactive event for BSNL's Franchisees to gain a concrete understanding of the necessary steps involved in performing a new site survey and analysis, planning and provisioning a network, deploying and maintaining a network and learning about the best practices required for ensuring a successful and profitable network deployment.

"Providing BSNL Franchisees with the tools to succeed will help deliver on WiMAX's potential to fully address today's broadband needs throughout the country," said Ron Resnick, president and chairman of the WiMAX Forum. "This workshop is one of many ways the WiMAX Forum is supporting our partners in India and around the world."

The WiMAX Forum and BSNL have invited more than 10 international WiMAX service providers, and more than 20 WiMAX vendors and ecosystem members to help share key lessons learned from successful greenfield WiMAX deployments and educate BSNL's franchisees. - Successfully completed the first draft of Release 2 Mobile System Profile (MSP) in Jan 2011; targets to publish the document in Q1 2011
- Has helped IEEE 802.16m to be adopted by ITU-R as an IMT-Advanced technology by providing relevant radio specifications

EVENTS UPDATE

On January 10-12, WiMAX Forum launched its Operator Summit Series with an extremely successful Global Operator Summit that was held in Taipei, Taiwan, and proudly welcomed 17 Operators. The following week, on January 17-21, WiMAX Forum held a CWG/NWG/TWG Face-to-Face meeting in Taipei, with 90 members in participation.

We are looking forward to seeing all of our members at our upcoming Member Conference in Xiamen, China, sponsored by Huawei. The Conference will take place on March 7-11, 2011.

The WiMAX Forum Marketing Team held a call with Marketing Working Group to discussed proposed 2011 industry events participation plan that was sent out in 4Q of 2010. Here is a summary of the updates made to the plan:

- 5th WiMAX Brazil Conference and Expo currently WiMAX Forum does not have enough vendor support to hold the event
- CTIA Wireless, March 22-24, Orlando, FL WiMAX Forum will participate in the program, but will not have a Pavilion

- Convergence India, March 24-26, New Delhi, India – WiMAX Forum invites member company to participate in member booth on the expo floor
- UTC Telecom, May 10-13, 2011, Long Beach, CA – WiMAX Forum is still planning to host a member pavilion and invites its member companies to participate. In addition, WiMAX Forum is pursuing a possibility to have a 1-day WiMAX event co-located with WiMAX Forum Working Group Face-to-Face in San Diego, May 9-13.
- WiMAX Forum Global Conference and Expo - a possibility of co-locating WiMAX Forum Global Conference with WiMAX India Event in 3Q of 2011 was discussed and is being pursued. In addition, WiMAX Forum is planning a series of regional events as part of its Operator Summit Series.
