OPERATOR SPOTLIGHT

This month the WiMAX Forum would like to feature an article from the Department of Public Relations of **MobinNet Telecom**.



With the beginning of 2013, the largest WiMAX Operator in Iran, MobinNet Telecom, celebrated reaching 450,000 subscribers of wireless broadband Internet.

MobinNet Telecom currently is one of the broadband Internet service providers with the most number of subscribers; and aside from that, MobinNet WiMAX is recognized as the country's largest nationwide wireless network. The live operation of over 1100 base stations, and the use of various products from three well-known WiMAX vendors in the access network are among the unique characteristics of MobinNet WiMAX Service, which have created complications in the integration and maintenance of the network. To overcome these issues, different types of IOT (Inter-Operability Test) and evaluations of equipment performance were conducted at the level of the protocols and standards of WiMAX, which have provided unique and innovative solutions.

In the middle of 2010, MobinNet WiMAX Network was launched, covering all provincial capitals of Iran; and now, after two and a half year, it offers various WiMAX-based services to more than 450,000 subscribers, with the indoor coverage of 134 cities, including all free trade zones and major cities of the country.

One of the main reasons for the rapid growth of the number of MobinNet WiMAX subscribers is a vast channel of sales agents created throughout the country. Currently, around 700 independent companies have received the license of sales services after passing initial training. In addition, more than 200 technical agents in Iran are responsible for providing after-sales customer services of the MobinNet WiMAX.

MobinNet Telecom Co. has already distributed more than 500,000 CPEs; including outdoor, indoor and pocket modems. Many different services based on the nationwide MobinNet WiMAX Network are provided for the largest companies and organizations in the country, among which the Virtual Private Network (L2VPN, L3VPN), Internet with Dedicated Bandwidth, National Data Network and MobinNet National Wireless Network can be cited.

Inherent features of IEEE 802.16e WiMAX Standard (including security, establishing a fast connection, allowing service prioritization and quality (QOS)) has created favorable conditions for private secure wide area networks. Thus, by understanding the market demands and needs as mentioned above, MobinNet Telecom launched a dedicated service called "Virtual Private Network" on its wireless infrastructure. Due to high security, reliability and availability of the network, users of this service consist of banks, financial institutions, insurance companies, large corporations and so on. The service is being used as the main communication platform in most cases and as the second backup in the other cases.

Now, by providing this secure point-to-point communication services for more than 4,200 branches of private and state-owned banks and large organizations in the country, MobinNet Telecom is recognized as the market leader of wireless broadband service provider in Iran.

Key Updates

• The WiMAX Forum is happy to announce four new Working Group Officers. Brian Crowe of Hitachi was nominated and selected as the Aviation Vice Chair, Lee Joo Aun of YTL was nominated and selected as TWG Second Vice Chair, and Steve Rosen of YTL and Leohnard Korowajczuk of CelPlan were nominated and selected as SPWG First and Second Vice Chair, respectively.

• The WiMAX Forum recently published four Release 2.1 document revisions to the previously published Release 2.1 documents. These documents can be found on our public website linked here: **Release 2.1 Document Revisions**.

• WiMAX Forum working groups had productive meetings at our Member's Conference in Kuala Lumpur from March 11- March 14. There, working groups continued to work on board initiatives and roadmap items. The AWG, SPWG, TWG, NWG and CWG met to collaborate on specifications and requirements. Two additional Release 2.1 document revisions were completed and approved by the Technical Steering Committee (TSC). These documents are currently undergoing WiMAX Forum publication process and will be published on our public library in early May.

The WiMAX Forum **Working Groups** are the key to the development of WiMAX technology. Working Groups are chartered by the WiMAX Forum to bring together content experts from member companies to contribute to and harmonize documents and specifications and perform other tasks that the WiMAX Forum has determined to be necessary or useful. Principal members of the forum have the opportunity to participate as officers of working groups when there are vacancies.

The WiMAX Forum organizes its technical activities through a number of Working Groups that produce technical requirements, technical specifications or advise the forum. These groups are coordinated by the Technical Steering Committee. The WiMAX Forum Working Groups include:
