WORKING GROUPS

The **WiMAX Forum Working Groups** are key to the development of WiMAX technology. The WiMAX Forum organizes its technical activities through a number of Working Groups that produce technical requirements, develop technical specifications, or advise the forum. Working Groups are chartered by the WiMAX Forum to bring together content experts from member companies. These experts contribute to and harmonize documents and specifications and perform other tasks that the WiMAX Forum has determined to be necessary or useful.

There are currently two active Working Groups focused on **AeroMACS** and **Smart Energy**. It is a crucial time for your organization to influence and leverage the Working Groups activities. If you are interested in participating in our **Working Groups**, please contact us at **info@WiMAXForum.org** and we will be glad to speak with you about this opportunity.

AeroMACS Public Key Infrastructure (PKI), AeroMACS Product Certification, and the FCC AeroMACS Petition for Rulemaking are the three main technical activities that the Aviation Working Group is currently working on. The WiMAX Forum and ICAO collaborate in the oversight of AeroMACS PKI for the ecosystem in an AeroMACS Advisory Council (AAC) and have partnered with Eonti to manage and implement AeroMACS PKI as the Management Authority (MA) for AeroMACS PKI. The Management Authority is in the process of finalizing the auditing process for the first commercial AeroMACS PKI Certificate Authorities, and will begin to bring these CAs onboard in the first of 2018. The AeroMACS Certificate Policy (CP) is complete and will be published in Q1.

The AeroMACS Designated Certification Laboratory (ADCL) continues to run two more products through Radio Conformance Testing (RCT). In parallel, the AWG Certification Task Group is validating test procedures for Protocol Conformance Tests (PCT). The Interoperability Tests (IOT) procedures to support AeroMACS based on current implementations is underway to

support an overall certification for AeroMACS compliance in 2018.

On February 21, 2018 the WiMAX Forum and the SEWG hosted a live Webinar with in depth details on how to promote the use of 3.65 GHz Spectrum under the CBRS Rules. Speakers addressed key questions about the spectrum, technology, CBRS changes and how to leverage the use of 3.65 GHz spectrum under the CBRS constrains.
